Numbers increased to 800 cattle, up 50 head. Overall it was a very good quality yarding. Weaner & lighter yearling cattle made up the bulk of the yarding however there was also a good supply of cows. Prime vealers suitable for the local trade were fully firm & 5c/kg dearer for a few select calves. Feeder steers again saw the best of the market. 350kg & better where up to 20 cents dearer. Selling to a top of 320.6c/kg. The heavier end saw the most improvement. Feeder heifers were also dearer, selling to 269.2c/kg, up 10c/kg on 400kg types, while the medium weights improved 5c/kg. Prime heifers to the processors were firm to 5c/kg better. Heavy steers/heifers met solid competition, the lead made 301.2c/kg, up by 7 -10c/kg. A good quality offering of cows saw solid competition from the buyers. Best heavy cows topped at 220c/kg, overall they finished firm to 5c/kg dearer. Bulls saw no change.
