Numbers remained similar this week for a yarding of 470 cattle up by 20 head. It was another very good yarding of cattle. This week saw a few more lighter weight restocking types. A full field of buyers were at the rail with extra couple of buyers also in attendance. A very good quality offering of localtrade cattle. Once again the southern processors were the most active. Prime steers topped at 424.6 cents while the heifer portion reached a top of 410 cents. Supermarket weight cattle sold very similar to last week however didn't reach the individual highs of last week. Feeder steers sold to 432.6 cents for medium weights. Restockers & backgrounders paid to a top of 495 cents for some 260 kg Angus weaners. Heavy steers & bullocks lifted 5 to 6 cents to reach a high of 385.2 cents. Cows also gained 5 to 10 cents. Bulls saw no change.
