Numbers fell by 50 head for a light yarding of 220 cattle. It was a fair quality yarding with a handful of better yearling steers & heifers penned. Not all regular buyers in attendance & the market leaning towards cheaper trends. Limited numbers of vealers/prime yearlings for the local trade, best calf in the shed topping at 316c/kg, however most selling between 270-290c/kg. Light weight feeder steers were firm reaching 285.2c/kg while the medium/heavy weight feeders were back 10c for better bred british breeds & more for the crossbred types. Not many cows yarded & they sold to cheaper trends, back 10-12c/kg with quality a contributing factor. Bulls remained fully firm.
