An exceptional yarding of 680 cattle were offered for sale. Yearling steers and heifers made up the bulk of the yarding, along with some very good export cattle. Not all regular buyers were in attendance in what was a strong sale.

- Prime local trade butcher cattle were in short supply and sold 10-20 c/kg dearer, topping at 509.2 c/kg for light weight vealers.
- Another good offering of yearling steers suitable for the feedlot orders. Angus steers topped at 475.6 c/kg. Majority sold firm to a few cents cheaper from the previous sale.
- There was an excellent offering of yearling heifers, suitable for both feedlot orders and the processors. Included was a consignment of 140 Angus & Charolais X heifers, 1 mark ex Bylong. They met solid competition to be 20-30 c/kg dearer. Heavy feeder heifers reached a high of 436 c/kg
- Good numbers of export types sold 10-20 c/kg dearer. Generally, between 385 to 410 c/kg
- 5 cows sold to a top of 313 cents, which was up 5-6 c/kg
- Bulls 10 c/kg dearer
- Restocking types were again in high demand selling to 602 c/kg
