Nunbers lifted this sale a yarding of 945 head up by 170 cattle. It was a good quality yarding with plenty of prime stock along with good runs of yearlings more suited to the feedlot. A couple of extra buyers were present & at the rail this week where competition was solid. Some very good prime milk vealers sold to weaker money this week. Reduced demand saw prices ease for the majority however select lots were fully firm. A very nice run of mostly medium to heavier feeder steers were stronger. Angus steers sold fully firm for the top end however gained 10 cents for the biggest % other british and euro cross steers sold to better demand & saw price gains of up to 20 cents. Feeder heifers also sold fully firm. A beautiful penning of heavy steers & heifers sold to very solid demand however they sold slightly cheaper only 3 to 5 cents mostly. Cows were very similar with only quality related variations. Bulls gained 10 to 20 cents.
