Numbers increased by 375 head for the 1st sale of the new financial year for a total yarding of 1175 head. All regular buyers attended & competed strongly in a mostly dearer market. Overall quality & condition of the yarding was not quite to previous sales with some cattle showing the effects of the cold weather. Good prime local trade cattle were limited in numbers but sold fully firm on last sale. Best locat trade cattle sold to 430 cents with most selling between 400 to 420 cents. There were good numbers of feeders offered best support was on heavy Angus feeder steers 450 kg they sold to a high of 475 cents up by 10 to 15 cents. Medium weights to 460 cents and lighter weights sold generally between 410 to 450 cents. Not the weight in the feeder heifers this sale with majority 280 to 350 Kg they saw very little change. Heavy export types were keenly sought. They generally sold fully firm. Buyers were very active to secure cows. A big jump of 20 to 25 cents. Best prime heavy cows saw a high of 366.2 cents. There was good restocking support on cattle 280 kg plus however buyers were a little harder on very light weights. Bulls sold 10 cheaper.
