# emon Meringue Rocky Road.

Servies 30 - Prep time 30 minutes

Mix up your regular rocky road with this lemon coconut version. Its sweetness is offset by the curd & you won't be able to resist the little speckles of cranberry!

### **Ingredients:**

- + 125g scotch finger biscuits, chopped
- + 125g white marshmallows, chopped
- + 75g mini meringues, chopped
- + 1/2 cup shredded coconut, toasted
- + 3/4 cup dried cranberries
- + 500g white chocolate, melted
- + 1/2 cup lemon curd

#### Method:

- 1. Grease a 20cm x 30cm slice pan. Line base and sides with baking paper, allowing a 2cm overhand on long
- 2. Combine the biscuits, marshmallows, meringues, coconut, and 1/2 cup of the cranberries in a large bowl. Add the melted chocolate and mix to combine. Spoon the mixture into prepared pan and press down evenly.
- 3. Sprinkle with remaining cranberries. Dollop teaspoons of the lemon curd all over the rocky road. Refrigerate for 1 hour or until set.
- 4. Remove rocky road from pan. Using sharp knife, cut crossways into 5cm wide bars. Wrap bars as gifts or serve in pieces.
